## SIZE GUIDE - BRACELET

### HOW TO USE THE WRIST RULER

- Cut out the paper Wrist Ruler
- Insert the pointed end through the slit you have cut at the other end indicated [cut here]. Place your hand through the Wrist Ruler and pull the pointed end until it fits comfortably on your wrist.
- The number that lines up with the edge of the slit is your wrist size.

When measuring your wrist keep in mind what kind of bracelet you are about to purchase. If it is a bangle, please size a snug fit. If it is a chain or link bracelet, please size with a touch of breathing room to allow for movement.

### SPECIFICS

**Life bracelets:** Measure a snug fit and then choose a size 1-2 cm larger than measured for a comfortable fit. Life bracelets should be tight on the wrist.

#### Leather:

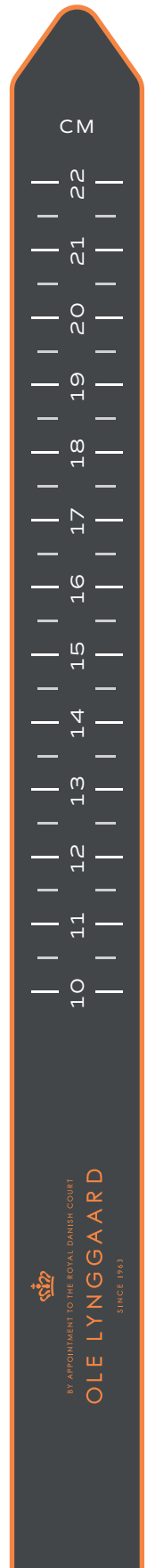
XSmall (Length 34 - 36cm)	Large (Length 40 - 42cm)
Small (Length 36 - 38cm)	XLarge (Length 42 - 44cm)
Medium (Length 38 - 40cm)	XXLarge (Length 44 - 45cm)

#### Silk:

XSmall (Length 33 - 35cm)	Large (Length 40 - 42cm)
Small (Length 36 - 38cm)	XLarge (Length 42 - 43cm)
Medium (Length 38 - 40cm)	

Please note that the Wrist Ruler is an indicative guide only and therefore may not be an exact measure.
